An exciting collaboration between Movement in Worship, Psalm Drummers and Images of Light!

The 2016 'Essence: School of Worship & Mission' previously known as Summer School will explore the dynamics of **worship** and **mission** through **movement**, **percussion** and the **supernatural realm.** We'll be connecting land, people and the Holy Spirit through worship, intercession, the prophetic, dream interpretation and more.

Building on a devotional and Biblical foundation Essence splits into three training streams, 'Movement', 'Percussion' and 'Spirit-Led Outreach'. Each participant will choose which stream they will do for the week, but they'll also get a small taster of the other streams.

The **'Movement Stream'** includes an exploration of moving in worship individually and corporately, the use of props and intercessory and prophetic movement. All participants will be prepared for moving on the streets.

You will need to bring suitable clothing for moving inside and outdoors – we suggest stretchy trousers, long tops and sturdy dance shoes or trainers. Flags and props will be provided, but you are also welcome to bring your own.

Through group work, the **'Percussion Stream'** explores worship and prayer using rhythm. You will be challenged and helped to become more creative in using your playing to connect with God and to communicate Him to others.

We can provide a limited number of workshop-level djembes and percussion instruments. It is essential that you tell us in advance if you will need this. Feel free to bring your own percussion and hand drum.

The **'Spirit-Led Outreach Stream'** is grounded in understanding the Father Heart of God for the world and will explore creative ways through which we can engage with the culture of today and impart His love. Through dynamic teaching and practical activation, participants will learn about going deeper in the prophetic, the realm of the Spirit, biblical

dream interpretation, and ministering to the human spirit with the purpose of incorporating these expressions of ministry in an outreach setting.

These streams merge together to take worship, intercession and the prophetic out into the community. If you opt for the Movement or Percussion Stream please bring dark coloured trousers and bright one-colour tee-shirts to wear when we go out. Those on the Spirit-Led Outreach Stream will wear everyday clothing when we go out.

This is a transformative week for the students and teachers. We are excited to see what God will do in and through us. One of the highlights is always the community that is built throughout all aspects of the week including the fun social evenings.

## Who can come?

No previous experience in dance, drumming, the prophetic or outreach is needed as experienced trainers will be facilitating the week.

The minimum recommended age is 12 years and there's no maximum age! Please contact us if you have children under 12 years who would like to attend. All under 16s need a participating guardian with them, who will be responsible for their behaviour and engagement.

# What content will be covered?

Each of the five teaching days will start at 9.30am and will include prayer, worship, biblical teaching and practical application that will build as the week progresses. Bring a notepad and pen so that you can make notes throughout the week. There are two mission events where we'll be taking our worship out into the city of Edinburgh; these times will be facilitated by the teachers.

We're also transitioning from the teaching section of the week into a 'Next Wave' continuous worship event, where participants can come to as much or as little as they like. During this time we'll have our final outreach a **Spirit.Rhythms** event where we'll be inviting the local community to come into the Wellsprings venue where we'll have a drum circle with dance using a range of prophetic evangelism tools ... let's see what God will do!

## **Hosts and Teachers:**

The 'Essence: School of Worship & Mission' is a joint collaboration between Movement in Worship, the Psalm Drummers and Images of Light. For several years we have partnered together in worship and mission across the UK. The school will be hosted by **David & Maggie Hewitt** at Wellsprings, which is the Scotland Movement in Worship base. The main teachers will be:

The **Movement Stream** will be led by **Andy Au** and **Kirsty Hallett** the directors of Movement in Worship (MIW). Andy founded MIW over 35 years ago; he also leads City Gate Church in Brighton. Kirsty has been dancing and teaching with MIW for over 15 years and she coordinates MIW internationally. They have danced and taught at a wide range of conferences and events in the UK and internationally. Their passion is to press into the presence of God and to take that presence out into the world. Together they bring over 50 years of experience of teaching and equipping people to worship God creatively in and out of church buildings.

The **Percussion Stream** will be led by **Michelle Tennens**, a hand drummer and percussionist. Michelle works with groups of all ages and ability to equip and enable them to use rhythm in worship and mission. She regularly facilitates drum circles for MIW combining her passion for rhythm and movement as she works with the drummers and movers.

The **Spirit-Led Outreach Stream** will be led by **David Hewitt** in conjunction with **Jeannine Rodriguez-Everard**. David leads Wellsprings Community and has coordinated many prophetic outreaches in Edinburgh such as Spirit Rhythms, with dreams and spiritual insights tables in places like Starbucks and local bookstores. His passion is to mobilise the local church to go 'under the radar' in offering people an encounter with the Lord. Jeannine is president of Images of Light and has many years of experience in developing Spirit-led outreach teams that minister the love of God through the prophetic, dream interpretation, art and inner healing. She is passionate about imparting the Father's heart for the world and spurring the church on in bringing Heaven to Earth through intimacy with Him.

## How to book:

The balance will be due **on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2016.** We will not have facilities to take card payments so please come ready to pay by cheque or cash. Alternatively you can pay the full payment before the first day of the school. Please note the cost of the course **does not** include accommodation or food.

# Accommodation:

Wellsprings community is able to offer a limited number of space for informal selfcatering accommodation in the Prayer Room (some floor mattresses, sofas etc which will need to be cleared each day for the room to be used for one of the teaching Streams) if people bring sleeping bags & pillows, and if possible, inflatable beds. Kitchen facilities, showers etc available. There is a nominal charge of £25 per person for the week to cover overheads. Please contact David Hewitt on <u>david@wellsprings.uk.net</u> to check for availability.

In addition, there are a few accommodation options available locally at a Premier Inn (Newcraighall) 5 minutes away on foot, and B&B or self-catering university accommodation at Queen Margaret Uni nearby (15+ mins by food / 5 mins by car) – if a group shares a 6 bedroom flat it could work out as cheap as £127.50 each per week there. Also by car there are various B&Bs (see Wellsprings website for some names <u>www.wellsprings.uk.net</u>). You may also find other accommodation on the Visit Scotland website. The venue is on the Lothian No.30 bus route and is a short walk (5-10 mins) from the Newcraighall Railway Station.
